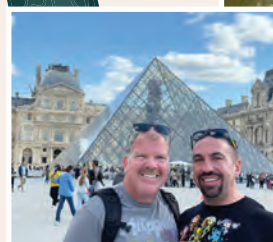
our home & pets

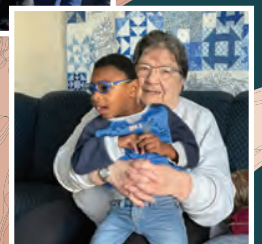
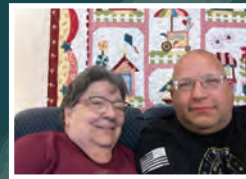
