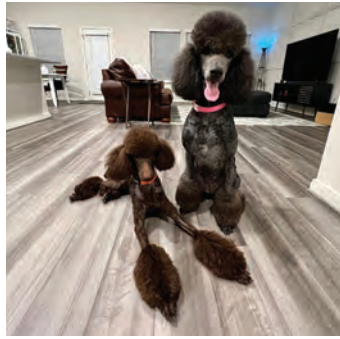


ADRIAN + LOGAN
