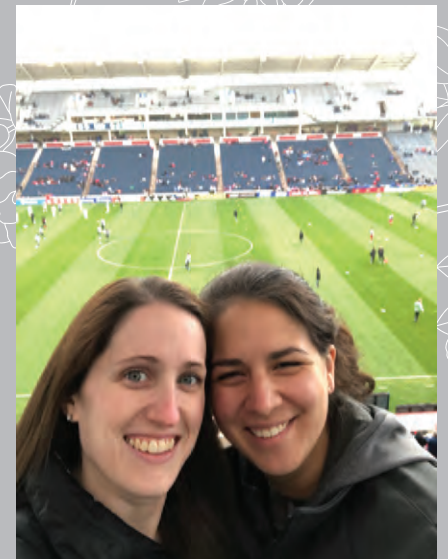
OUR HOME + PET
