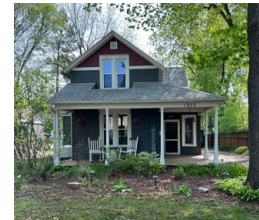


about us

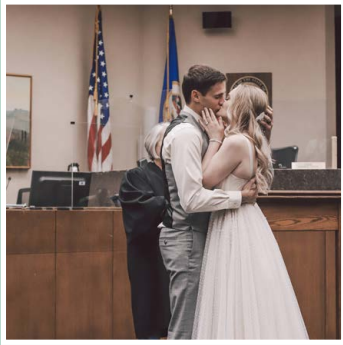
our home + pets

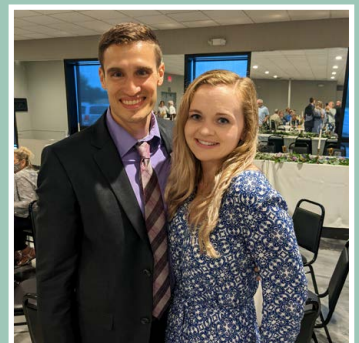
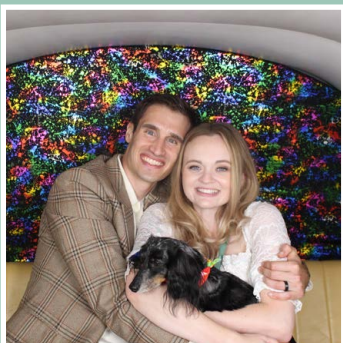


what led us to adoption

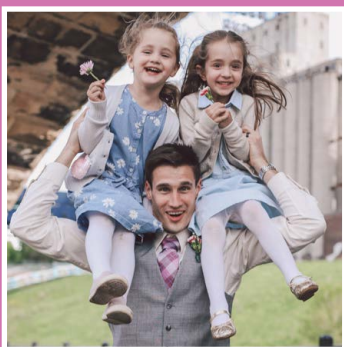
