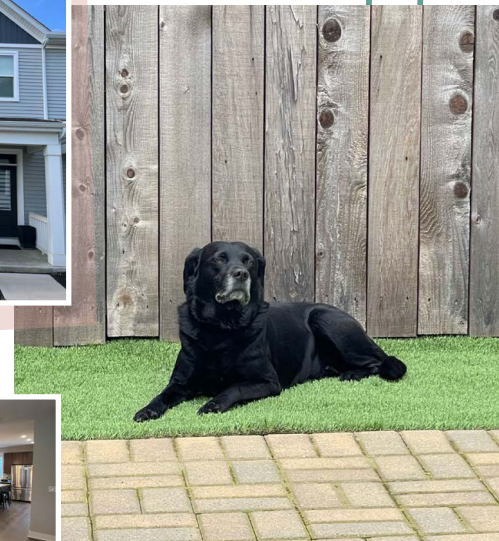
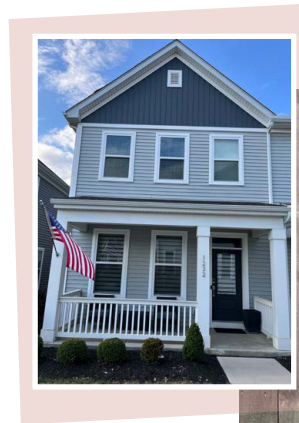


## OUR LIFESTYLE

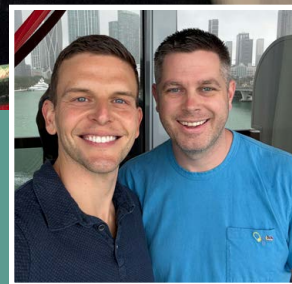


## ADOPTION IN OUR LIFE

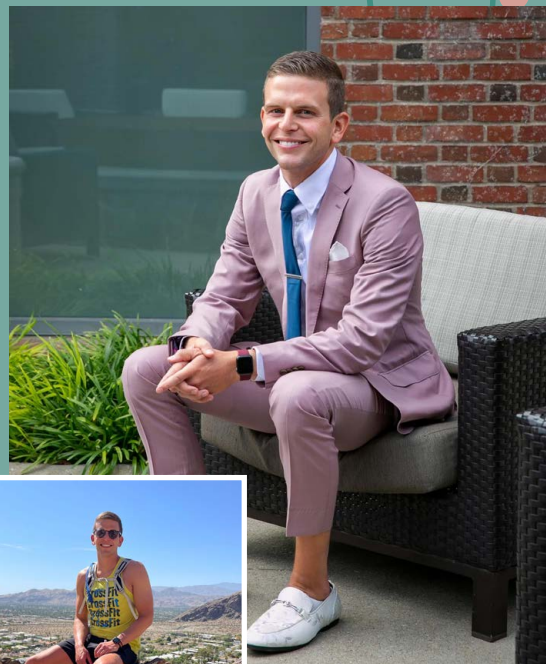
