OUR HOME

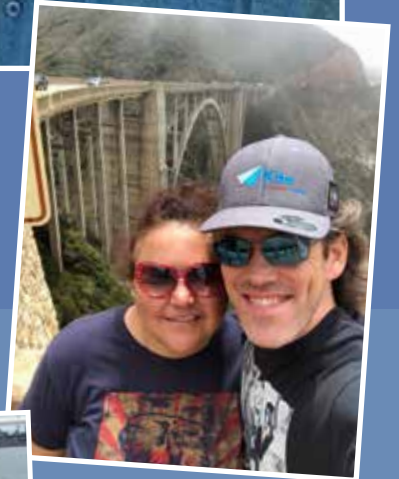
