## *our home and pets*

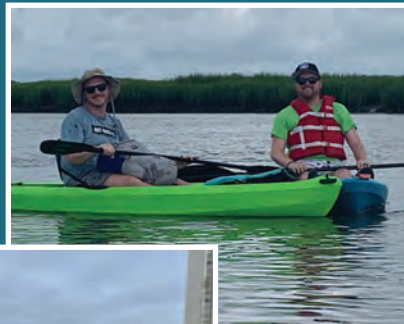

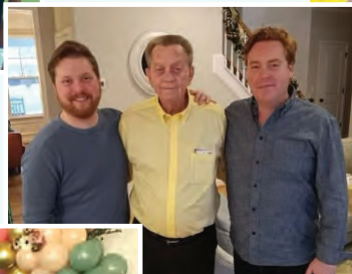
*our family*
