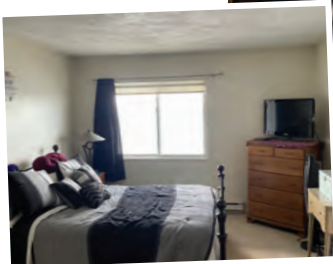

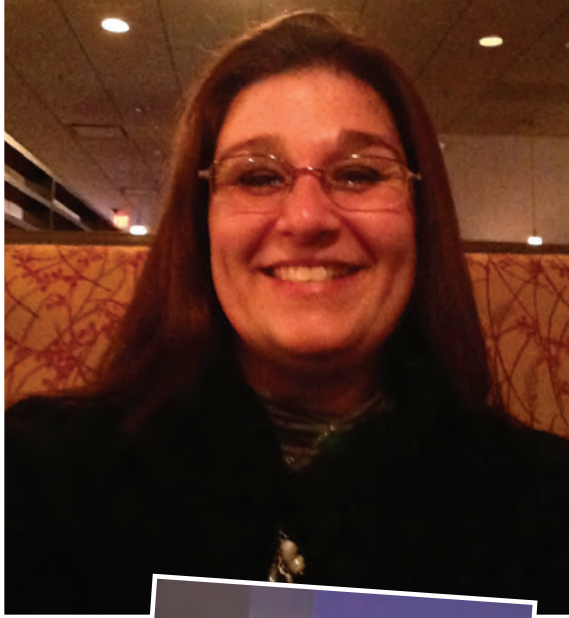
## WHAT LED ME TO ADOPTION
