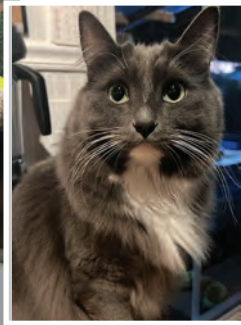
About us

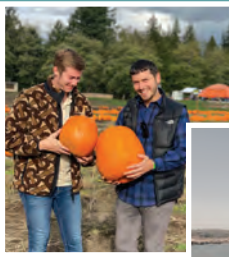
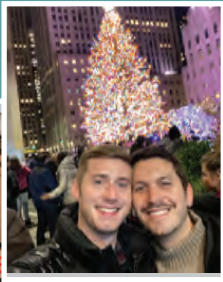
Our home + pets
