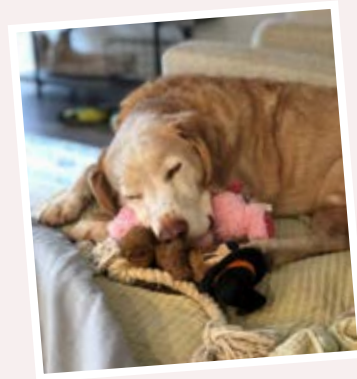
ABOUT ME

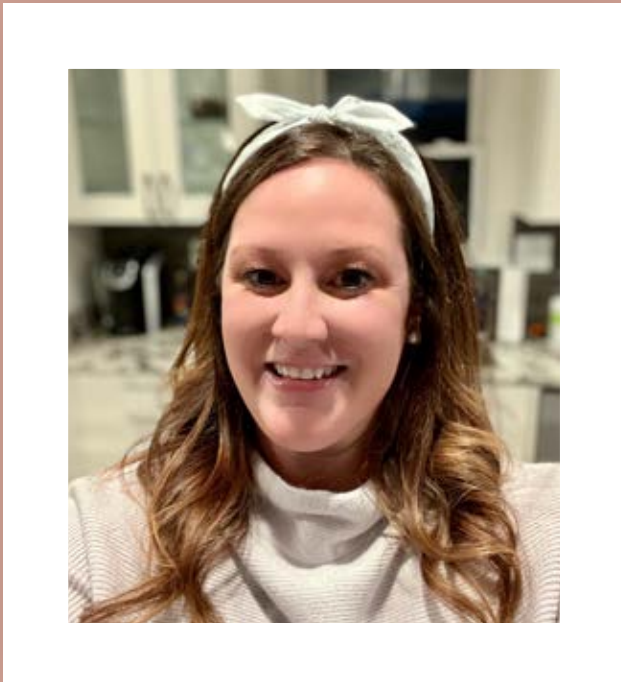

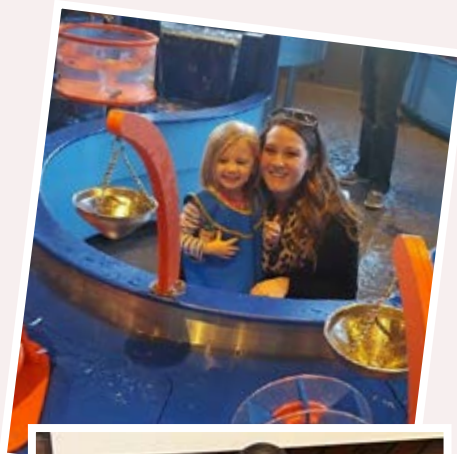
