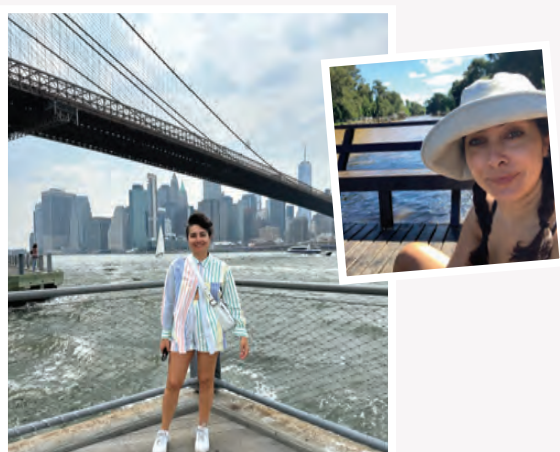
ABOUT ME

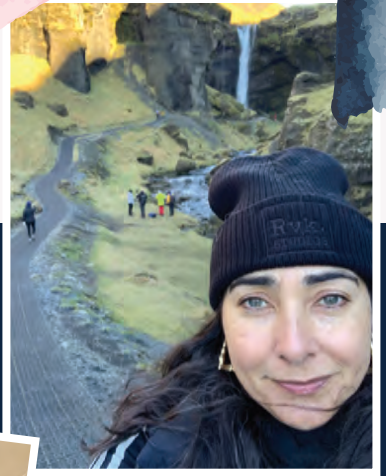
MY HOME

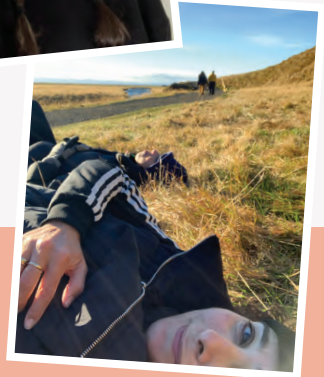
