ABOUT US

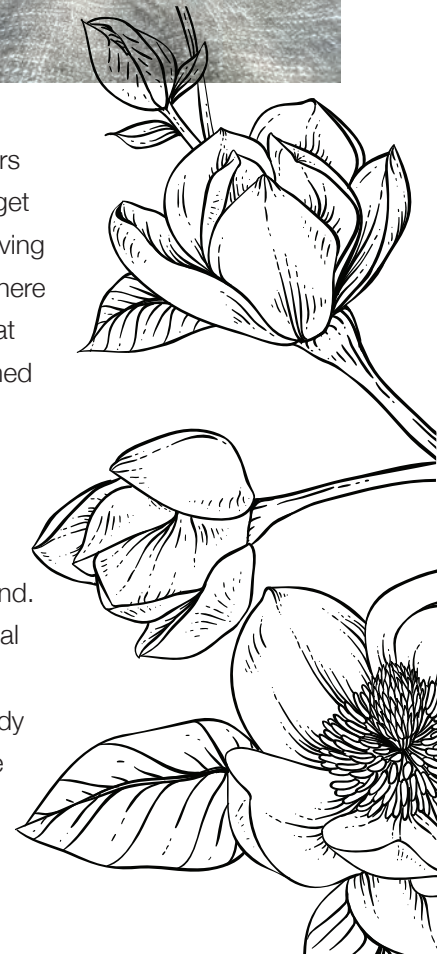
