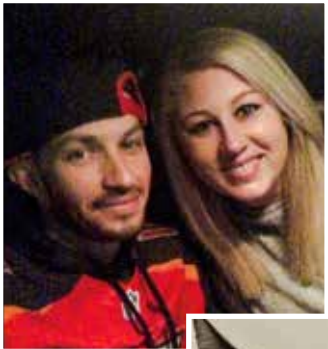
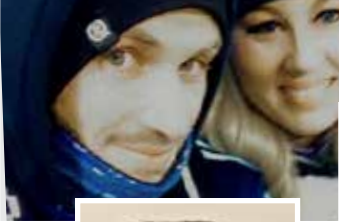
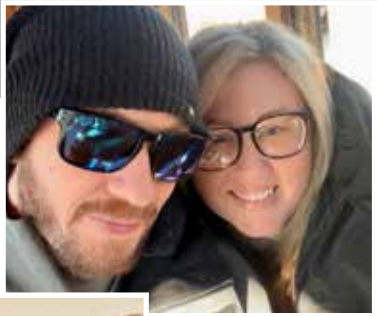
## *what led us to adoption*
